3. Purpose for processing – Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of the organisation of artistic open-air sessions at the Baltic Gallery of Contemporary Art and the promotion of the Gallery.

5. Data Retention Period – Your personal data will be kept for 10 years and processed on the basis of your consent unless it is withdrawn.
